## Swiss Travel System tickets and passes.

Swiss Travel System tickets and passes are the key to Switzerland's extensive public transport network. They guarantee nearly unlimited travel by train, bus and boat.


**Swiss Travel Pass.**  **Covers:** unlimited travel by train, bus and boat, including premium panoramic trains, plus public transport in more than 90 towns and cities. Youth travellers aged under 26 receive a 15% reduction off the normal price of a Swiss Travel Pass. **Validity:** 3, 4, 8 or 15 consecutive days. **Bonus:** 50% reduction off most mountain railways, free admission to more than 500 museums.


**Swiss Travel Pass Flex**  **Covers:** unlimited travel by train, bus and boat, including premium panoramic trains, plus public transport in more than 90 towns and cities. Travellers aged under 26 receive a 15% reduction off the normal price of a Swiss Travel Pass Flex. **Validity:** 3, 4, 8 or 15 freely selectable days within one month. **Bonus on travel days:** 50% reduction off most mountain railways, free admission to more than 500 museums.

**Swiss Transfer Ticket.**  **Covers:** return travel by train, bus and boat from a Swiss border station or airport to a holiday destination. The outward and return journey must both follow the direct route. **Validity:** two transfers within one month.

**Swiss Half Fare Card.**  **Covers:** up to 50% reduction off travel by train, bus and boat, as well as most mountain railways and public transport in more than 90 towns and cities. **Validity:** 1 month.


**Swiss Family Card.**  **Covers:** available free of charge and on request when purchasing any regular Swiss Travel System ticket. Children under 16 travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with a valid Swiss Travel System ticket.

## Adventure tips.

Switzerland is a country of many aspects. Her natural and cultural assets manifest a genuine quality grown over the centuries. Selected adventure excursions reveal the rich diversity of original and artless authenticity.

**LAKE LUCERNE**  **Lake Lucerne MS Diamant**  
The new, stately motor vessel MS Diamant captivates visitors with its impressive size, futuristic design and excellent amenities: The Nautilus room offers deep insights into the underwater world and on the terrace at the stern, passengers enjoy a refreshing lake water footbath. This diamond cruises between Lucerne and Flüelen.



**Glacier 3000 (Alt. 2,965 m)**  
The view of 24 legendary mountain giants that opens up at the summit station – designed by Swiss architect Mario Botta – is a revelation: from Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau via the Matterhorn to the Grand Combin and the Mont Blanc.

**Lötschberg mountain route and Centovalli**  
Via Kandersteg and Goppenstein to Brig, from Locarno at the Lago Maggiore to Italy: On many detours, the BLS Lötschberger and the Centovalli railway carry travellers to great excursion destinations of delightful scenic splendour.

**Four passes route by PostBus across the Central Alps**  
Starting from Meiringen and tackling four of the most impressive Swiss Alpine passes by PostBus in one single day, thereby negotiating a total altitude of 10,366 metres: This panorama tour represents the ultimate experience for Alpine enthusiasts. It can be booked from June to October.

## Rochers-de-Naye (Alt. 2,042 m)

Hiking trails at 2,000 metres altitude, marmots from three continents and plants from all over the world: This route promises unlimited view of the Swiss and French Alps and offers the possibility of a romantic overnight stay in a Mongolian love yurt (nomad-type tent) – year-round!

**Voralpen-Express**  
En route from St. Gallen to Lucerne, passengers discover a different kind of Switzerland: They savour the picturesque villages along Lake Constance, the gently undulating hills of the Toggenburg, and the untouched natural beauty and enchanting charm of the pre-Alps. The route is part of the Grand Train Tour of Switzerland.

**Travelling by bike**  
Swiss public transport is perfectly fit for cyclers and mountain bikers. At more than 300 railway stations, info boards by SwissMobil facilitate the access to every bike route. 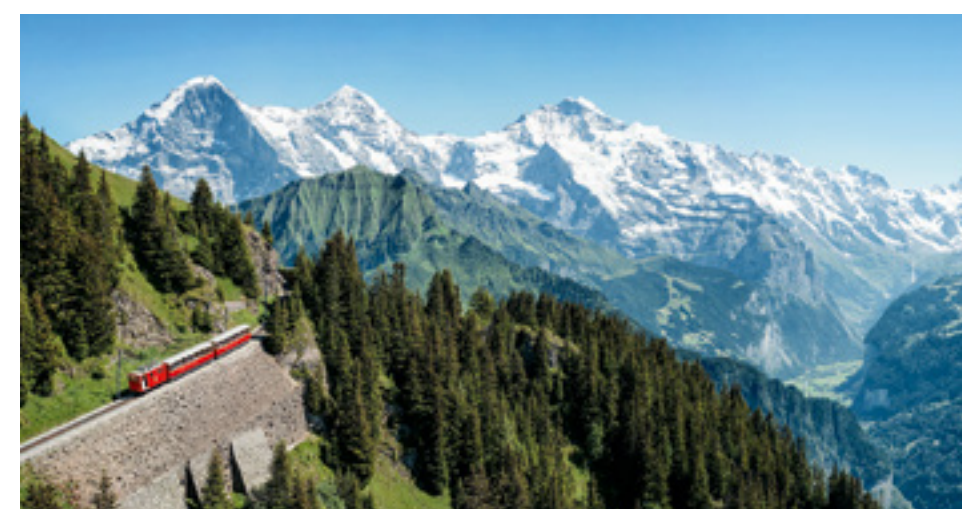

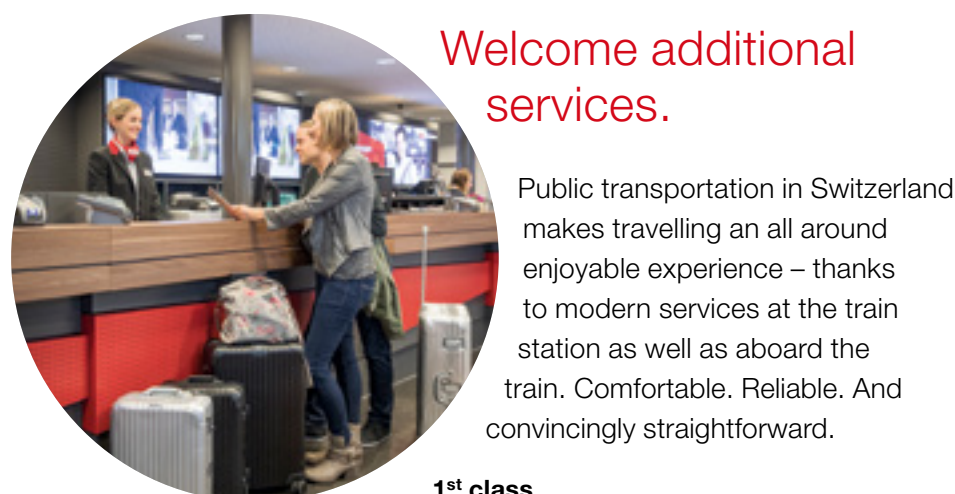

## Mountain excursions at a discount.

**5 Gornergrat (Alt. 3,089 m)**  
Amid 29 4,000-metre peaks, the Gornergrat offers a spectacular 360° panoramic view from the Matterhorn to the Dufourspitze. From Zermatt station, it is Europe's highest-altitude open-air cogwheel that railway takes passengers towards this stunning summit – 365 days a year.

**6 Jungfrauoch (Alt. 3,454 m)**  
Top of Europe – high Alpine fascination of eternal ice and snow. It's a destination of unfailing magical power. Clear days allow the eye to rove almost endlessly from the Vosges to the Black Forest. The train arrives via tunnels through Eiger and Mönch.

**7 Pilatus (Alt. 2,132 m)**  
The Pilatus is accessible via two routes: by panorama gondola and aerial cableway, or by the world's steepest cogwheel railway. At all times an inspirational destination for people of all ages – with a rope park and a summer toboggan run, hotels and restaurants.

**8 Titlis (Alt. 3,020 m)**  
It's the only accessible glacier in Central Switzerland and sports the highest rope bridge in Europe – not to mention an impressive glacier relief. Even the ride up to the summit in the Titlis Rotair, the world's first revolving aerial gondola cableway, is an adventure.

## Best photo spots in Switzerland.

Whipping out the mobile phone or bringing the camera into position in order to eternalise the most famous sights? Picking three out of many more great photo spots, here are some suggestions to find the perfect angle.

**The Verzasca Dam**  
James Bond famously jumped down the 220-metre-high Verzasca dam wall, thereby lending to it a lingering touch of Hollywood glory. The position next to the world's highest bungee jumping station guarantees an action-packed photo. Venturing the jump oneself even more so.

**The Rhine Falls**  
Standing high above the largest waterfall in Europe, feeling the water masses reverberate through one's body – and catching that very moment on camera. The giant rock in the middle of the waterfall is easily accessible by boat.

**The Matterhorn**  
In still air, the Matterhorn is beautifully reflected on the crystal clear surface of the Lake Riffelsee (2,757 m). Photo buff hunters experience this natural marvel of by taking the Gornergrat railway to Rothenboden and braving the roughly 10-minute walk to the lake – mornings or evenings.

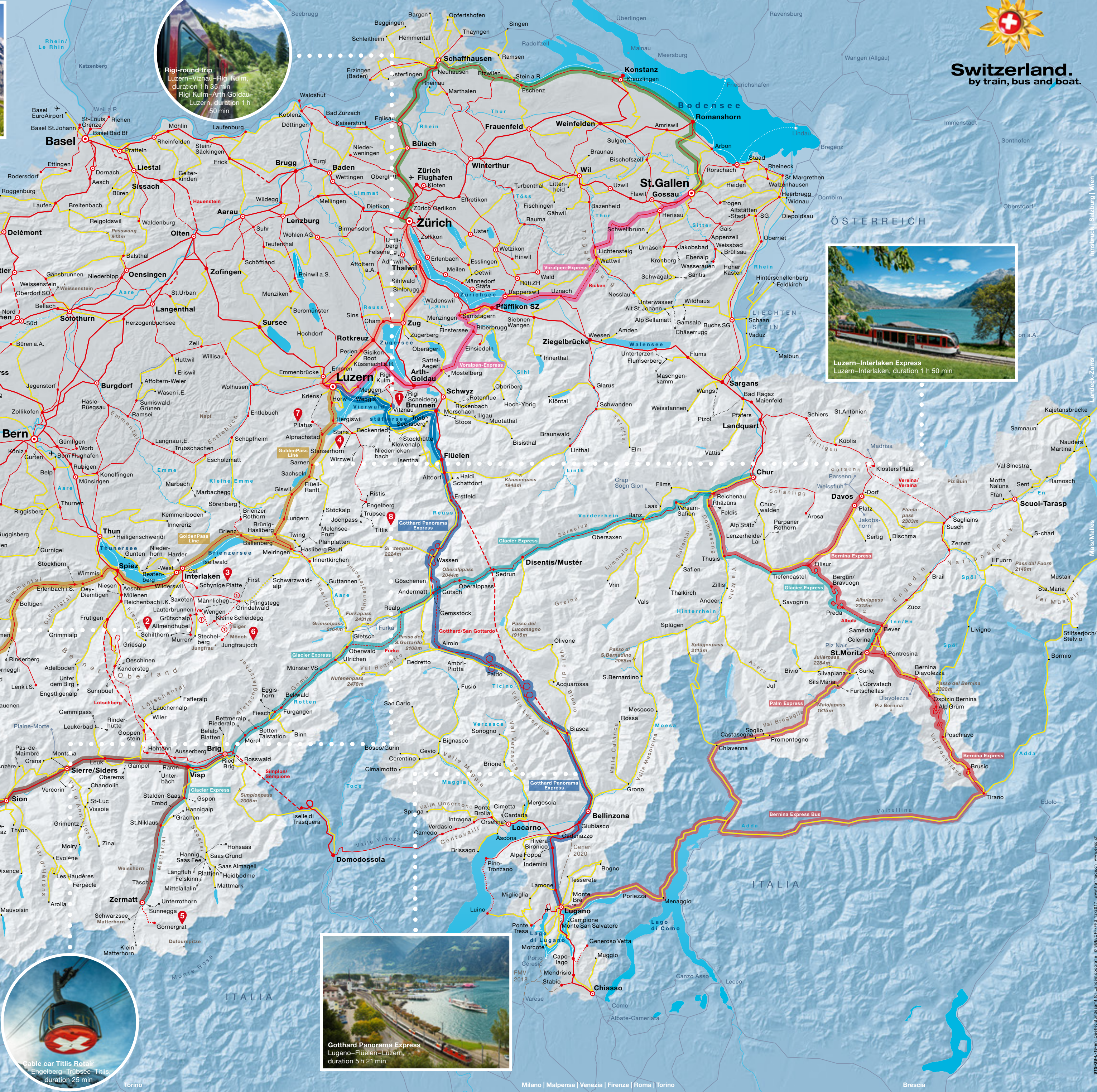
